

## SECTION 013 - CAVIES (Guinea Pigs)

Wednesday - 9:30 a.m. (Breed Classes)

**\*\*\*Rabbit and Cavy owners are responsible for the complete care of their animals while they are at the fairgrounds. Owners of animals that require special care must be available to attend to their needs.\*\*\***

#### **BUNNY/CAVY SALES:**

**Saturday, August 21, 2010 at 5:00 p.m.**

**PLEASE NOTE: The bunny/cavy sale policy for exhibit-ors who wish to sell their bunnies/cavies at fair is as follows:**

**-The only time bunnies/cavies are to be sold and picked up is on Saturday, August 21, between 5 and 7 p.m.**

**-Absolutely no money can be exchanged until this time. This will help to limit misunderstandings that may occur when people try to reserve bunnies by paying in advance. –Rabbits/Cavies must be sold and removed by their new owners before clean-up/tear-down begins at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday night.**

**Cloverbuds will compete and be awarded premiums & ribbons, and will follow the same rules as a regular 4-H member.**

- 1 Exhibitors are limited to not more than one entry in each class, except in the case of different breeds or varieties within the breed.
- 2 Senior Boars and Sows shall be over 6 months of age and over 30 ounces (850 grams).
- 3 Intermediate Boars and Sows shall be up to 6 months of age and weigh over 22 ounces and up to and including 30 ounces (625-M grams).
- 4 Junior Boars and Sows shall be up to four months of age and weigh from 12 ounces to 22 ounces (340-625 grams).
- 5 All Cavies will be judged on the group award basis - excellent, good, worthy; but ARBA Standards will be followed.
- 6 All Cavies must be in place by 5 p.m., Monday night and remain until 8 p.m. Saturday. Exhibitors removing Cavies before 8 p.m. will forfeit all premiums that may have been awarded.
- 7 All cages will be cleaned by exhibitor or all premiums will be forfeited.
- 8 Cages will be furnished by the Fair Association.
- 9 The Fair Board will not be responsible for loss, damage, mistake or accident.
- 10 Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show, will be

selected.

- 11 All entries should be pre-registered before fair. Send all entries to: Cornell Cooperative Extension, P.O. Box 184, Hamden, NY, 13782. These entries are due by July 23.
- 12 Cavies can be purebred or of mixed breeding; please enter this information on entry form.
- 13 Stock showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the show.
- 14 All Cavy exhibitors will be required to show in showmanship on Tuesday at 9:00 a.m.
- 15 The Cavy shown in Showmanship must also be shown in its breed class.
- 16 If the exhibitor is not present for Showmanship, his or her Cavies will not be judged on Wednesday.
- 17 Cavy exhibitors must be present at the Cavy judging Wednesday starting at 9:00 a.m. Exhibitors are expected to present their Cavy(ies) to the Judge. If the exhibitor is not present, the Cavy or Cavies will not be judged.

#### **CAVY BREED SHOW – WEDNESDAY, 9:00 A.M.**

Senior – more than 2 lbs.

Intermediate – less than 6 mos; 1 lb. 6 oz to 2 lbs.

Junior – less than 4 mos; less than 1 lb. 6oz.

#### **CAVY SHOWMANSHIP - TUESDAY, 9:30 A.M.**

Each exhibitor will present his or her own Cavy to the Judge on an individual basis. Each exhibitor will be judged on appearance, handling of animal and presentation to the Judge. Questions will be asked on the breed, grooming, and parts of the Cavy.
