

## SECTION 032 -- CLOVERBUDS

### **PROJECT RECORD SHEETS REQUIRED FOR YOUTH BUILDING ENTRIES.**

A General Project Record or Cloverbud Project Record and an Exhibit Tag **must** accompany each exhibit entered in the Youth Building. A copy of the General Project Record is enclosed in the fair book. Additional copies of the Project Record Sheet can be found in past issues of the 4-H Leaders' Digest, our web site at [www.ccedelaware.org](http://www.ccedelaware.org) or by visiting or calling the 4-H office.

Fair book classes that required a 3" x 5" index card attached to an entry in the past is no longer required. The Project Record Sheet will take the index card's place.

#### **4-H Cloverbuds must be actively enrolled with the 4-H Office.**

- 1 Cloverbuds are allowed to participate in the following animal classes: Poultry, Rabbit, Cavies, Ducks, Turkeys and Geese. **Cloverbuds will compete and be awarded premiums & ribbons, and will follow the same rules as a regular 4-H member.**
- 2 4-H Cloverbuds ages 5, 6 & 7 will be allowed to participate in a special Cloverbud Class in the Goat, Sheep, Swine and Horse (as noted in horse classes) sections.
  - a Cloverbuds will receive an incentive award and will receive a cloverbud rosette. Participants will not be placed. This is a participation class, not a competition class.
  - b Cloverbuds must show young animals. Animal should be born after February 1st, and the Cloverbuds must have worked with the animal from February up until Fair time. The Cloverbuds must be able to control the animal. Halter and leadline are recommended where appropriate.
  - c Older members or adults helping in the ring is acceptable.
- 3 In addition, Cloverbud members may participate in the Club Booth, Club Parade and Public Presentations (if they did one in February). Cloverbuds **will** receive premiums for these events. See specific Sections for details.

#### **Class No. 2950**

4-H Cloverbud members age 5-8 are invited to exhibit 5 entries of items (in addition to animal classes) done as a result of the Cloverbud project book, or any other appropriate item in the area of foods, clothing, art objects, crafts, photography, scrapbooks, woodworking, natural resources, and garden vegetables.

Cloverbuds will receive an incentive award and will receive a cloverbud rosette. Participants will not be placed. This is a participation class, not a competition class.

Each exhibitor **must** fill out one green Cloverbud double entry card with all exhibits entered listed on the back.
