Each driver will be limited to one entry per class. Each horse may be entered in a class no more than 3 times. Any participant showing in youth classes will not be allowed to show in adult classes. Participants will show one or the other but not both. Any classes running past 10p.m. will be cancelled and entry fees refunded.

Health requirements are the same as for the Monday Draft Horse Show. Use Horse Van Entrance. Have all papers ready at the gate.

This is a show designed with the intent that the participant and the audience will have FUN. There will be no judging of horses. All classes are run on a time/faults basis on driver's ability.

An animal, for this show, shall be any draft horse/pony pulling the required wagon/cart using HEAVY HARNESS.

ALL YOUTH PARTICIPANTS (DRIVERS/RIDERS/HELPERS) ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE AND WEAR THEIR OWN ASTM APPROVED HELMETS WHEN ON A WAGON, WHETHER IN THE SHOW RING OR WARMING UP.

There will be FOUR DIVISIONS:

- Sec. 1: Adult driver age 17 & over driving Horses.
- Sec. 2: Youth driver age 8-16 driving Horses with an adult on seat.
- Sec. 3: Adult driver age 17 & over driving Ponies/Mules.
- Sec. 4: Youth driver age 8-16 driving Ponies/Mules w/an adult on seat.

Combo Classes: 7 & 8 will receive Adult Premiums paid to horse owner.

All classes are through a preset obstacle course and are timed. Faults shall be assessed as follows: Hitting an obstacle - 5 seconds; Off course - 15 seconds. Judge's decision is final. Timer's time is final.

NOTE: THE FAIR BOARD/ DRAFT HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT to cancel any premiums earned for driver and horse/horses if any of the above rules are broken.

Combo Class Rules:

- § Male and female to drive a split-class. This can be Adult/Adult or Youth/Adult to drive, but each Combo must have one Adult and must be a male/female combination.
- § One driver goes through obstacle in one direction then passes the lines to the other driver who continues through the same obstacle in the opposite direction.
- § The switching of drivers needs to be completed before entering the first obstacle, after crossing the start/finish line.
- § Time for both drivers combined for one time
