Special features for **Wednesday and Thursday** table settings featuring decorative units consisting of fresh plant material to be arranged by the exhibitor. In addition treated plant material and accessories will be allowed. An accessory is anything in an arrangement in addition to plant material, container, or base. It must not be the primary focus of the design.

No artificial flowers or silks. No flower shop or grocerystore flowers. No disposable products; paper/plastic plates, cups or napkins. No silverware. The same decorative unit may not be used on both days. Children must set their own table. An exhibitor may exhibit one formal and one informal table setting each day.

- Formal table settings consist of crystal, candles and china.
- Informal table settings consist of items you would use for an everyday table.
- All tables are to be functional with one place setting per table
- Exhibitors are asked to furnish card table and neatly pressed cover for each exhibit.
- Exhibits must be in place for judging by 10 a.m. each day, and removed by 8 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. the same day. The Grand Champion Table Setting and all First Prize Table Settings can be displayed through the remainder of the week.
- Table settings will be judged the following: idea (overall theme), general appearance (cleanliness of items, proportion of items), proper setting (proper placement of dishes, glassware, etc.), and harmony (centerpiece, linens, dishes, glassware harmonize).
- Premiums will be awarded for worthy exhibits only; see Fair Rules. When deserving, more than one Blue Ribbon may be given.

Each day a Lillian Beardslee Memorial Award is chosen, this Grand Champion Table Setting is chosen by the judges and may not necessarily be the same as the First Prize winner.
