The Art Show welcomes entries from artists residing in or owning property in Delaware County. PLEASE NOTE: Due to the adding of more categories we are asking for one entry per categories with Professional and Armature only.

All Artwork can be brought to the fairgrounds Saturday, August 15th from 9 AM-3 PM. Special arrangements can be made by contacting the Art Committee by calling 607-865-.6809 or through your schools Art Teacher.

No Art work will leave the building before 8 PM Saturday, August 22. For your convenience artwork may also be picked up on Sunday morning, August 23rd between the hours of 9 AM and 12 Noon. Your Art will be returned to your Art Teacher if it was submitted by your teacher if not you are responsible to

make arrangements. The Art Committee will not be responsible for items left in the building after Sunday, August 25th.

Because this is a family oriented Art Show, this Committee reserves the right to reject or refuse, and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its members, is not eligible or worthy of showing, or has not met the entry requirements. This Committee also reserves the right to reclassify any exhibit. Prizes will only be given when deserving, whether there be competition or not. When deserving, more than one Blue Ribbon may be given.

Taxidermy will no longer be accepted in the Art Show.

All pictures must be properly matted and framed in the adult division. Please be sure all paint is dry. All oils and acrylics must be framed, unless galley wrap canvas is used. All photographs must be framed. Artwork should be properly wired and secured with wire hanging apparatus on the back. Please use picture wire only. Work must be sturdy. NO TAPE should be used to support wires on back of work or entries will be refused.

PLEASE NOTE: BECAUSE OF THE HEAT IN THE BUILDING, TAPE WILL NOT ALWAYS HOLD. We are not responsible for any work that falls apart. Owner's name, address, and phone number must be on the back of all work.

No Live Animals Of Any Sort will be allowed to be displayed in the Art Department.

Any Photograph that has been deemed to be doctored in any way (photo shopped, air brushed, etc.) shall be re-classified into the category it best benefits.

There are four divisions (SECTIONS):

100 ... PROFESSIONAL - defined as persons who offer their work for sale or who instructs. Professional artists may display their business cards with their work after judging. Exhibits may be marked for sale, but arrangements must be made privately.

200 ... **AMATEUR** - open to all entrants over 18.

JUNIOR - all entrants grades K-12 will compete in the Junior Division, unless you qualify as a Professional. The Junior Division will be subdivided according to grades just completed:

Elementary: Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5-6.

Junior High: Grades 7 - 9. High School: Grades 10 - 12

Three entries per category may be submitted
