Interstate cattle must have an ICVI (Interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) within 10 days and an avian flu test done at a NAHLN lab (National Animal Health Laboratory Network – Cornell is the only one in NY, but there are others in other states) within 7 days of arriving at the fair.

The cattle must also have all the requirements of intrastate cattle, including BRDC vaccination (bovine respiratory disease complex with all four major viruses covered), a rabies vaccination given by a veterinarian within 12 mos. for animals 4 mos. and older, an 840 RFID ear tag recorded on the ICVI and HPAI test, and a negative BVD-PI test.
