***PLEASE NOTE CHANGES TO THIS YEARS SHOW!**

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS. NO DOGS, BICYCLES OR LASER LIGHTS.

Dairy Goat exhibitors must have original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and registration papers. The state veterinarian will check each animal and health papers before unloading. A copy of the health certificate must be sent with the entry form.

NEW FOR 2025! The Delaware County Fair Board has decided OPEN SHOW DAIRY GOATS ONLY ARE NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE THE RABIES VACCINATION (March 2023 Board Meeting). All 4H entries still require proof of Rabies Vaccination.

This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and is open only to animals that are registered in the following associations: ADGA, AGS and CGS. ADGA rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned.

READ AND FOLLOW ALL RULES:

1. Prior to sending entries read “Standards of Conduct of Fairs” and “Livestock Requirements”. Exhibitors must follow standards available at delawarecountyfair.org.

2. Exhibits must be put in place by 9:30 A.M. Sunday, August 16th 2026. Open class exhibitors will be allowed to leave the fairgrounds at the conclusion of the show.

3. *There is a \$3.00 entry fee for each class.*

4. *There will be Premiums awarded this year.*

5. **Entries must be received by August 11th 2026.**

6. **Animals must be penned there is not an option to show off trailers at the Delaware County Fair all pen space needs to be reserved with entries.**

7. The base date for computing the age is the day of show. August 16th 2026.

8. Each exhibitor will supply his/her own feed and bedding. Exhibitors are responsible for cleanup of their area or a donation made back to the Open Dairy Goat Show is appreciated. **Helpers who are willing to stay and help clean up and reset pens will be offered Ice Cream vouchers.**

9. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the Show Secretary before start of the show. The original registration or duplicate registry application stamped by ADGA is required on all animals under six months of age.

10. There will be no pre-show milk-out.

11. No bucks to be shown.

12. An exhibitor may enter as many animals per class, but ribbons awarded as judged.

13. Animals shown in group classes must have been shown in individual classes.

14. A family may show as one exhibitor or members of a family may show as individual exhibitors. Borrowing of animals is permitted in classes 9, 10 and 11 only.

15. Check of entries, classes and registration papers will occur prior to the start of the show.

16. All goats must have a permanent form of identification that coincides with both veterinarian inspection certificate and registration papers (if applicable).

17. No horns on dairy animals.

18. Substitutions are allowed with breed section at no extra fee.

19. Vehicles and Trailers will be allowed in the area for loading and unloading only. They must be parked in designated areas during the show. Our show committee will arrange transport back to the show area with our golf carts.

Breeds

Entries must be recognized as a Dairy Goat breed. The show will follow this order until each breed is complete.

This Combined Jr/Sr show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association for the following breeds: Alpine, Guernsey, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Oberhasli, AOP (including Toggenburg, Nubian and Sable), Recorded Grade. **The show order may be changed by the show committee.**
