

## Department HH – Collections

**All entries need to be called in and confirmed with Lisa Calaci before the Fair as there is a limited space.**

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS. NO DOGS OR BICYCLES. NO LASER LIGHTS.

Due to limited space, entries for this department will ONLY be accepted by phone. Please call Lisa Calaci to enter.

Display booths will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Booth sizes: 4' x 4' and 4'x 8' (limited number of each)

Display Booths may be set up on Saturday, August 9th between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., or on Sunday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, between the hours or 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. All entries must be in place by 4 pm on Sunday, August 10<sup>th</sup>.

Because this is a family oriented fair, this committee shall reserve the right to reject or refuse, and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its members is not eligible or worthy of showing, or has not met the entry requirements. Anyone willfully entering in the wrong class will forfeit their prizes. This committee also reserves the right to reclassify any exhibit.

The building is overseen at all times while it is open during the fair. The building is locked at night and security guards are on duty. However, the Association is not responsible for anything damaged, lost or stolen.

### Instructions for entry and Rules:

1. Call Department Chairperson to reserve a booth and get a confirmation number for your entry (607-434-3377).
2. After reserving booth with Department chairperson, complete and submit entry form, entering confirmation number as part of the description of the exhibit.
3. In addition to naming the class, please briefly **DESCRIBE THE EXHIBIT** on the entry blank.
4. Limit: One entry per class per exhibitor and one class per booth per exhibitor.
5. Professionals may enter, but must indicate such on the entry form. A professional is one who sells the articles exhibited.

6. Exhibitors in Collections must be 16 years of age or older (may be waived at the discretion of the Chairperson).
7. Any poster or index card information on your entry might be helpful to fairgoers.
8. Exhibitors must supply their own decorating materials for their display booth.
9. **ALL entries must remain until 8 pm Saturday, August 18th.** Exhibitor must PRESENT THE TAG STUB WHEN PICKING UP EXHIBIT. Exhibitors must pickup exhibits between the hours of 8 p.m. and 9 p.m. Saturday or 9 am to 11 am Sunday.
10. The judges' decisions will be final. Entries will be judged by content, appearance and originality.
